

Bible Study Guide
“Book of Revelation”
Lesson Fifteen

Revelation chapter nine dealt with the fifth and sixth trumpets which were also called the 1st and 2nd woes. Let’s see how far we get this lesson into chapters 10 and 11.

1. **What type of a chapter is Revelation 10 – and how so?** (Similar to another we covered already)
2. **Who might this angel be mentioned in Verse 1, and what does the symbolism mean in verse 2?**
3. **Who else makes pronouncements with this angel and, what is different here – in verses 3-4?** (To what is this referring? – consider: 1 Sam.2:10; Psalm 18:7-15; Psalm 29:3-8)
4. **What, in verse 5-6, does this mighty angel now do – and how is this similar to an Old Testament prophecy?** (Consider Daniel 12:4-7; 8:23-25)
5. **What won’t be delayed any longer – as told by the angel in verse 7?**
6. **What does this dialog mean in verses 8-10 about the little black book – and what was John to do?** (Consider Ezekiel 2:7-3:3)
7. **Then, in Chapter 11:1-2, John is told to do something else – what could this mean?** (Consider 1 Peter 4:17; Luke 21:20-24; Daniel 11:40-45; Zechariah 14:1-4)
8. **Then comes one of the more pronounced and speculated prophecies of Revelation in verses 3-7. What does all of this mean? Who are they?** (Consider: II Thes. 2:9-11; Rev. 16:13-14; 13:1-8; Zechariah 4:2-7, 14; Rev. 1:20; Exodus chapters 7-11; 1 Kings 17:1; James 5:17; Rev. 17:7-8; and Dan. 7)
9. **There are some dramatic events that take place with these two again in verse 8-13 – What could all of this mean?** (Consider: Dan. 11:40-45, Mat. 24:15-22; II Thes. 2:1-4; Mat. 24:30, Mark 13:26, 14:62; and I Thes. 4:17) **This concludes what?**
